## **General Secretary Unavailability**

## **DBS and Safeguarding Children**

Each Friday I receive a list from Devon FA informing me of any coaches or Club officials without either an in-date DBS or a Safeguarding Children Certificate. The number of outstanding issues has reduced dramatically over the last two months and our League now often has none outstanding. If any are passed to me Clubs are informed that coach or official can not be involved in junior football until outstanding issues are resolved. My thanks to Welfare Officers and Club Secretaries for their support in these matters.

#### **Transfer Window now closed**

I would like to thank the Registration Secretaries and Emergency Transfer committee for their work over the month of January that has enabled many transfers to take place. I would also like to thank Clubs who have enabled transfers to take place and enable more children to play regular football with new Clubs.

## **Deregistration of Players**

Now the transfer window is closed for the year players can only be deregistered if they have missed five consecutive games, or a Club requests a deregistration and I am sent an email from the parent confirming that they wish their son or daughter to be deregistered. 21 Days must elapse from the date I receive the correspondence. The only other way a player can move is through emergency transfer, but these will only be agreed in exceptional circumstances. Secretaries of Clubs please do not give my telephone number out to get parents to phone me as the above rules are very clear. I understand during the transfer window the need sometimes to get clarification, but I ended up speaking to over 20 parents over the last month and their intervention made no difference to any of the decisions made by the Executive.

A reminder to all teams that have an outstanding pitch fee, central league invoice or fine that they need to be paid by no later than the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and Nicola thanks all Clubs that have already made their payments. Nicola will also be sending out the invoices for teams that have transferred a player or players in either of the two transfer windows for Season 2024 – 2025
